This two-day event will also include an exhibition of Cowell's manuscripts, notes, and artwork at both concerts, and a pre-concert panel discussion on November 13th featuring JOHN DUFFY (Meet the Composer founder, student of both Cowell and Aaron Copland), JOEL SACHS (New Juilliard Ensemble, Continuum, author of forthcoming Cowell biography), legendary record producer GEORGE AVAKIAN, violinist ANAHID AJEMIAN, pianist SARAH CAHILL, and CHARLES AMIRKHANIAN of Other Minds.
